- **Trinity** – The Father, Son and Holy Spirit
- **Greatest Commandment** – ‘love your God and your neighbour as yourself’
- **Greatest Commission** - ‘Go forth and make disciples of all nations’
- **Prayer** – Way of Christians practicing belief
- **Pilgrimage** – Iona (Scotland), Lourdes (France)
- **Creation** – Genesis 1
- **The Fall** – Humans ‘fell away’ from God because of sin
- **Original Sin** – The first sin in the Garden of Eden
- **Incarnation** – God as flesh
- **Crucifixion** – Jesus was killed on the cross
- **Resurrection** – After 3 days Jesus came back from the dead
- **Ascension** – After 40 days Jesus went up to heaven
- **Atonement** – Being at one with God
- **Judgement** – God will judge everyone
- **Salvation** – Being saved from sin
- **Heaven, hell, purgatory** – Where Christians go after they die based on faith, action or grace.

Sikhism – Key concepts

- **Equality** – Belief that everyone is equal.
- **Oneness of God** – There is only one God
- **Reincarnation** – Your soul being reborn
- **Gurmukh** – Being God centred
- **Life cycle** of reincarnation of the soul
- **Mukti** – Liberation from the cycle of life and death
- **5 Khands** – The 5 stages to getting mukti, piety, knowledge, effort, grace and truth
- **5 Virtues** – love, compassion, truth, humility and contentment; help you be gurmukh
- **5 Vices** – anger, attachment, lust, greed and pride: make someone more manmukh
- **Haumai** - ego
- **Karma** – The consequence from action this can be good or bad
- **Manmukh** – Being away from God, man centred
- **Langar** – Free kitchen in a Gurdwara
- **Seva** – Selfless service, tan (physical), man (mental), dhan (material)
- **Wand Shack** – to share
- **Kit Karo** – work hard
- **Nam Jap** – Pray e.g read the Mool Mantra
- **Meditation** – Meditate on the name of God
