<b>W1: Capital city</b>	The city containing the centre of government in a country.	<b>Erosion</b>	When the Earth's surface is worn away by rivers, waves and ice.
<b>Island</b>	An area of land surrounded by water.	<b>Geologist</b>	A person who studies the Earth's crust and its rocks.
<b>Industrial Revolution</b>	A time when cities in the UK grew rapidly during a period of great factory growth after 1750.	<b>Drainage</b>	Water, mainly rivers and lakes.
<b>Relief</b>	The height and shape of the land.	<b>Estuary</b>	A large mouth of a river where it meets the sea.
<b>W2: Economic</b>	To do with money and wealth.	<b>Regional centre</b>	A large city, with many shops and offices, that serves the area around it.
<b>The North-South Divide</b>	The idea that there are significant cultural and economic differences between the north and south of England.	<b>Regions</b>	Nine areas, made up of several counties, which can be used to divide up the UK. An example would be the South East.
<b>Counties</b>	A division of the UK, such as Kent, made up of several districts or boroughs. Some counties are	<b>Districts</b>	Also known as boroughs, these cover local areas, such as Dartford. These councils provide local services.

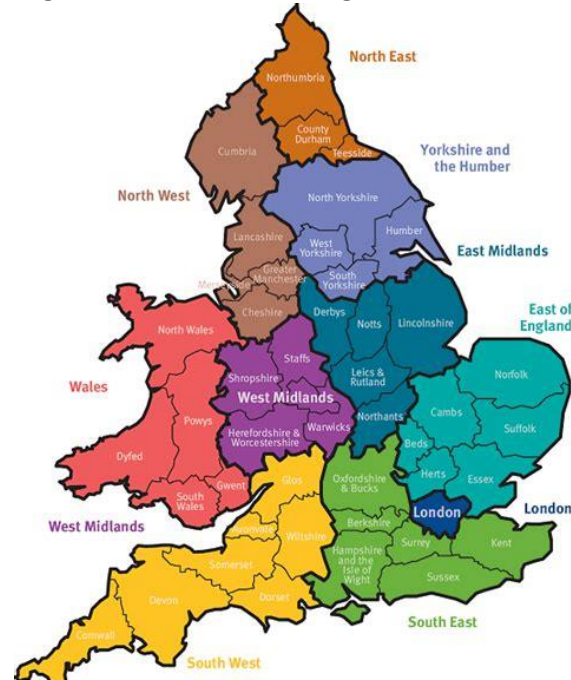
